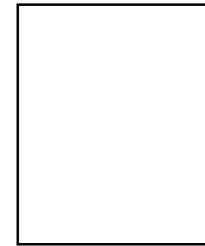

Introduction

Mahatma Gandhi Memorial College, Udupi, founded in the year 1949 by Dr. Tonse Madhava Ananth Pai was his dreamchild, visualised to bring education to the doors of the youth of Udupi and its neighbouring towns. Until then, there were only two colleges in the then Dakshina Kannada District and both were situated in Mangalore. Dr. Pai could inspire a band of enlightened citizens of Udupi to work towards founding the college in this town. The Project was termed then as the wildest of dreams. Dr. Pai faced many obstacles, and at one stage he had to even return the donations he had collected for the establishment of the college. But Dr. Pai, a man of grit that he was, did not forsake his dream of establishing the college. With sheer perseverance, he could mobilise public opinion in favour of the college and inspire and attract donors for this noble cause, irrespective of how much or how little they could contribute. Dr. Pai then had the task of bending the will of the much reluctant authorities of the Government and the University of Madras. With great effort, he secured the permission to found the college in the practically rural environs of Udupi. Dr. Pai's perseverance in this regard was equal to the legendary perseverance of Bhagiratha who brought the heavenly waters of the Ganga down to the earth. Dr. Pai still had another hurdle in his path. The University and the concerned authorities, in accordance with the prejudices of the time refused to grant permission to admit lady students and the famous 'Shantha Versus University of Madras' case was fought on the basis of equality of rights ensured by the constitution of India. The matter, then in the court of Governor, Sri Prakash, was settled in favour of girls with the timely intervention of Smt. Indira Gandhi who was not yet a prominent political figure, but only Jawaharlal Nehru's daughter.

Things did not move very fast, public opinion was slow to change and it was an uphill task. However, once Dr. Pai sincerely set out on his mission he got tremendous and overwhelming support from all concerned. The Swamis of the Ashtamatas of Udupi blessed the project. The public of Udupi willingly and freely offered shramadhan to raise the building on the site at Sagri where the college now stands. When the building was ready, in 1952, the college which was initially housed in an Elementary school was shifted to the present campus. A dedicated band of eminent citizens of Udupi stood by Dr. Pai and the dream of setting up a college became a reality.

That was six decades ago. Since then the college has witnessed a phenomenal growth and expansion. It is a premier Institution sponsored

by the Academy of General Education, Manipal and a pathbreaker to the citizens of many other towns who saw in Dr. Pai, a mentor and guide to help them in similar ventures. The era of higher education in the district also ushered in an economic revolution.

The college celebrated its Silver Jubilee, Golden Jubilee and lately Diamond Jubilee with great splendour. We can look with pride at the milestones in the path of the development of the college, including the inauguration of Madhava Raksha, the magnificent new Administrative Block by Hon'ble Minister for Human Resources Development, Dr. Murali Manohar Joshi, on the occasion of inaugurating the Birth Centenary Celebrations of our founder Dr. TMA Pai. In the year 2002, the new state of the art library (Granthaloka) was built.

The college is a premier Institution with its dynamic faculty known for their scholarship and academic excellence. The college also has a dedicated band of non-teaching staff who look into the diverse administrative tasks of the college. The college has carved a niche for itself in these sixty years of its existence.

The college began functioning with stalwarts and pioneers in the field of education like Prof. H. Sunder Rao, Prof. K.S. Haridas Bhat, who firmly established a tradition of academic and cultural activities in the campus, which was ably carried on by Prof. K Ramdas, Prof. K.K. Easwaran, Prof. K. Rama Bhat, Dr. Alwyn D'Souza, Prof. K Shreesha Acharya, Prof. P.N. Narasimhamurthy, Prof. S. Daniel, Prof. Dr. Gopalan Puthuseri, Prof. Ganapathi Bhat, Prof. M.L. Samaga and Prof. Dr. Jayaprakash Mavinakuli.

The College Trust has been the most enlightened one and spares no effort to take the college to its pinnacle. Dr. Ramdas M. Pai, President of the Governing Council and Sri. T. Mohandas Pai, President of the College Trust have taken on the responsibility of spearheading the various activities of the college. They continue the heritage of Dr. Pai of liberally sanctioning worthwhile projects to the College, intended to improve the amenities for the students and the staff.

A Library with more than one lakh volumes, innumerable journals and periodicals which could do credit even to a University, a roll of honour with names of rank holders entered every year; Yakshagana Kendra, with more than three decades' record of promoting the folk performing art of the region, the Rashtrakavi Govind Pai Samshodhana Kendra offering facilities for research for doctoral work, a Tulu Lexicon

Project Regional Resources Centre for Folk Performing Arts which undertakes challenging documentation projects with and from the Ford Foundation, a Department of German Language unceasingly at work throughout the year, cultural activities like the Vadiraja Kanakadasa Music Festival taking place every year, various activities organized by the students - these have brought to MGM College the status of an eminent educational institution worth the title of a Mini-university. The management caters to all the academic requirements of the students. Since 2005-06 the Department of Computer Science has been offering BCA degree course to meet the heavy demand for Computer trained professionals. Every year several students get placement in reputed companies which come to the campus for selection. Five Career Oriented Add-on courses sponsored by the U G C have been started. The college also gives training for the all round personality development of the students.

The staff of the college have earned a reputation for their unstinted devotion to work. They are academically oriented. Presently the college has ten teachers with Ph.D. degree and twenty two with M.Phil degree. Many members of the faculty are involved in research work for their doctoral degree from different Universities in their respective fields of study.

In accordance with the order of the Government of Karnataka, the Mahatma Gandhi Memorial college now has been bifurcated into Mahatma Gandhi Memorial College and Mahatma Gandhi Pre-University College, in the same campus.

Recently MGM College has been accredited with B grade. The NAAC peer team opined, " The College is one of the leading affiliated undergraduate Colleges of Mangalore University with a large number of students securing ranks at the University level. A large number of students from Commerce and Computer Science are being regularly employed through the 'Placement Cell' functioning in the College. A number of students represent the College at th State and National levels in extra curricular and co - curricular activities. The College offers value added education and sensitises the students to the local customs and rich cultural heritage. The College has a visionary and supportive Management Committee".

Presently Mahatma Gandhi Memorial College is headed by Prof. Dr. P Venkatramana Gowda and Mahatma Gandhi P.U. College by Smt. Malathi Devi and under their able guidance, zeal and dedication the College is scaling greater heights with a team of dedicated teachers.

PAYMENT OF FEES

1. The Academic year is divided into 2 terms/instalments for the payment of fees and the annual fees will be received in two instalments:
I Instalment : June/July
II Instalment: November/December
2. Every student shall be liable to pay the fees for the whole term during any part of which his/her name is on the rolls.
3. If a student fails to pay his/her fee on the day fixed for the purpose in the Calendar, he/she shall have to pay a fine at the rate of Re.1 per day. If the fee together with the fine is not paid within the last day for the fee collection with fines, the student's name shall be removed from the rolls. He/She will be readmitted only after he/she pays all his/ her arrears including fines and readmission fee.
4. The fees must be paid in the College Office during the working hours 9.00 a.m. to 1.30 p.m. on working days other than Saturdays and 9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. on Saturdays.
5. A receipt signed by the Principal or his deputy shall be issued for all payments.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Every student admitted to this College and studying in this college should clearly understand the implications of the Rules regarding Admission, Attendance, Discipline, College Examinations and Scholarships and Fee Concessions in this College as specified in this Calendar.

Every student of the College shall conduct himself/herself in a disciplined manner both inside and outside the campus.

He/she is expected to strictly adhere to the rules and regulations of the college.

1. Every student shall be present in the class as per the class time-table.
2. During leisure hours the students are expected to be in the library.

3. During class hours they are strictly forbidden from loitering in the corridors and the campus.
4. Every student is expected to maintain a sense of decency and decorum in his/her dress, as prescribed by the college.
5. Students shall not absent themselves from classes without genuine reasons endorsed by parents.
6. Any misbehaviour on the part of the student shall be severely dealt with.
7. The students' welfare council will consist of members nominated by the Principal on the basis of their conduct and studies.

NO ELECTION WILL BE HELD.

8. No student shall organise or participate in any picnics or tours without the permission of the Principal. Disciplinary action will be taken against those who violate this rule.
9. **Ragging is strictly forbidden. Any one found to be indulging in this uncivilised practice will be summarily dismissed.**

10. POSSESSION AND USING OF MOBILE PHONES IN THE COLLEGE CAMPUS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN. IF FOUND, IT WILL BE CONFISCATED. STRICT DISCIPLINARY ACTION WILL BE TAKEN. A PENALTY OF RS. 1000 SHALL BE PAID.

UNIFORM

Students of P.U.C and Degree shall wear the uniform prescribed by the College.

DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The College has a well-equipped Department of Physical Education Well laid out playgrounds are available on the College Campus for organising various games and sports. Separate facilities for men and women are provided. Besides, there is a small Gymnasium with a Multi-Gym and facilities for indoor games like Table Tennis, Carrom etc. Students are required to make use of all the facilities available and equip themselves with credit. For the efficient functioning of the Physical Education Department a Physical Education Committee is formed. The Committee comprises the Principal as the Ex-officio President and some staff-members and student representatives selected by the Principal.

The Physical Education Committee shall lay out the general policy regarding the Sports and Games activities in the College and decide on matters connected with them. In case of any difference of opinion the decision of the Principal shall be final.

1. Captains for the various games will be nominated by the Physical Director of the College.

2. Players for the representative teams in various games will be selected from among the players who are regular both for practice and for intramural games competitions. The selections will be made by the Physical Director in consultation with the members of Physical Education Committee.
3. Teams which do not carry out the instructions of the Physical Education teacher and are very irregular for practice will not participate in any competitions.
4. If the players selected are irregular for practice or if their conduct is not good they will not be permitted to participate in any tournament and such persons may have to pay back the expenses incurred for providing them with uniforms and such other things.
5. All players should come in proper uniform for the various games and sports.
6. In all games and sports the players are required to conduct themselves properly both in and off the fields. Each Player is expected to exhibit team spirit.
7. Students who receive the materials from the games room should return them safely to the person who has issued them.
8. The Playground should be kept clean. The materials used for sports and games shall be handled carefully.
9. Students are free to play between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on all working days. No student is permitted to play in the grounds in the campus during working hours.
10. No student on the rolls of the College is permitted to play in any external team in a particular event without the permission of the Principal.
11. In all matters of discrepancy and discipline Principal's decision will be final.

GENERAL TIPS - DOS

1. **Do look up the Notice Board Every Day.**
2. **Do enter the class well in time before the teacher enters the class.**
3. **Do make use of all the facilities and opportunities.**
4. **Do submit all the assignments, records and notes in time.**
5. **Do spend your free time when the lecturers are on leave, either by reading in the library or by staying in the vacant class rooms peacefully. Girls can stay in the ladies' waiting room.**
6. **Do keep the Ladies Waiting room neat and clean.**

DON'TS

1. **Do not idle away precious time by vain chatting.**
2. **Do not move around the campus in groups during working hours.**
3. **Do not sit on the stone benches under the trees during working hours 8.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.**
4. **Do not litter the classrooms and the campus.**
5. **Do not move about in the corridors during working hours.**

COLLEGE EXAMINATIONS

1. There will be two examinations for all classes - the Mid-Term Examination in August-September and the Preparatory Examination in January - February of each Academic year.
2. In addition to these 'term' examinations, lecturers will hold "tests" on the days prescribed.
3. No student shall absent himself/herself from any examination or class test without obtaining permission in person, wherever possible, from the Principal or in the case of the class-tests, from the lecturer. Violation of these rules may result in the imposition of such penalties as the Principal may deem necessary.
4. Cumulative records will be given to students twice a year with entries of marks and monthwise attendance. Students are expected to show them to parents/guardians, get their signature and bring them back to the respective Staff-Advisor.
5. Re-admission to the successive semesters will depend upon the progress of the student as shown in his/her examination and tests, on his/her conduct, behaviour and attendance.
- 6) A candidate, who fails to complete the programme within a period of three years after admission, shall be allowed to complete the programme within the next three years, i.e. within a total period of six years from the year of admission. However, not more than four attempts to pass any of the examinations of the programme shall be permitted. If the candidate fails to successfully complete the programme as specified above, he/she should seek fresh admission to the programme.

Rules regarding conduct of 1 year Pre-University Class examinations/Annual Examination:

- i) Minimum attendance: A student to be permitted to take the annual examination, must have put in 75% of the number of working periods in each subject.
- ii) An examination fee of Rs. 100/- per student will be levied to defray the expenditure on printing, stationery etc.

- iii) There will be two Tests, one Mid term examination and a Preparatory Examination.
- iv) The District Level I PUC Public examination results will be declared as per the rules of Pre-university Board.
- v) There will be Supplementary Examination for failed I year PU students.
- vi) Candidates who pass in all subjects of the I Year P.U.C. Annual Examination only are eligible for admission to the II Year P.U.C.

CUMULATIVE RECORD

A teacher will be in-charge of a group of students and will supervise the progress of his wards and guide them in their studies and co-curricular activities.

Each student will be provided with a Cumulative Record in which the monthly attendance and the marks at the class tests and term examination will be entered by the Staff Advisor. Each student is expected to show the cumulative record to his/her parents periodically and get the entries attested.

Parents are requested to insist on the submission by their wards of the cumulative record at least twice a year, once in September and then in February. Parents are requested to verify the attendance and marks obtained by the wards.

The cumulative record is a document reflecting the progress of the student in the course of his/her study in the college. It should be handled carefully by the student when it is in his possession and should be returned to the Staff Advisor immediately.

LADIES' HOSTEL

"Sri Vadiraja Vidyarthini Niiaya" is a ladies' hostel which can accommodate about 200 students. All the inmates of the hostel are required to keep the hostel neat & tidy with strict adherence to rules & regulations of the hostel. **Use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the Ladies Hostel.**

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-curricular activities for the students will be organised under different heads like Literary & Fine Arts Club, Commerce Club, Science Club and Players' Association, Sports and Games under the supervision and guidance of Staff advisors nominated for the purpose every year. The main purpose of these activities is to stimulate the student's interest in matters of general culture and to train them in the art of co-operative organisation and team work. Students are strongly advised to take part in these Club activities.

Participation of Degree Students in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities will be considered for 50 Marks and credits as per University Rules.

LIBRARY

Granthaloka- is a full fledged library with Ku.Shi. Jnana Mantapa - the reference library, separate reading rooms for boys and girls. Library catalogue has been computerised. Delnet, Infflibnet, Internet. OPAC and reprographic facilities are provided. Tantramshaloka - the computer wing which is all set to bring in an I.T. revolution attracts many students for various courses.

THE M.G.M. COLLEGE STUDENTS' CO-OPERATIVE STORES (REGD.)

The Store was registered in June 1952 (L. 720) as a Co-operative Society and all students of the College are its Associate Members or Share-holders. The store supplies all the text-books and stationery articles required by the students. Students are requested in their own interest to buy their requirements from the store. The profits of the store are distributed as scholarships to needy students.

NATIONAL CADET CORPS, NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME, RANGER UNIT, YOUTH RED CROSS

Students are advised to join NCC (Naval Wing for boys as well as girls and Army Wing for girls). Students with NCC Certificate (C) get an extra credit while seeking opportunities for higher education or employment.

The National Service Scheme (N.S.S.) aims at involving the youth in the service of the community. It will train them to fulfil their social responsibility as citizens. N.S.S. is education through service.

The N.S.S. Units of the College (consisting of 200 members) have a fine record of service for the past many years.

The Ranger Unit of the college provides opportunities to the girls to train themselves in self discipline and social service. The Youth Red Cross provides opportunities to the students to participate in social work and it develops their personality

ANNAPOORNA

“Annapoorna” houses the college canteen which has been offering very useful service by way of providing wholesome food at subsidized rate. The Mid-day Meals scheme provides free lunch to financially deprived and deserving students.

BANKING SERVICE IN THE CAMPUS

The Kunjibettu Branch of Syndicate Bank functions in the ground floor of “Nalanda”, in the College Campus with ATM facility.

RASHTRAKAVI GOVIND PAI SAMSHODHANA KENDRA

“Rashtrakavi Govind Pai Samshodhana Kendra”, an Oriental Research Centre, established in 1965 around the nucleus of a unique collection of 5,000 volumes belonging to the library of the late Poet-Laureate Shri Manjeshwara Govinda Pai is meant to organise research work in ancient history and literature-classical and modern. The “Centre” arranges annual lectures by renowned scholars and publication from time to time. It also runs an organised reference service.

The University of Mysore recognized this centre for research in History and Culture of the region, leading to the Doctoral degree. With the establishment of the Mangalore University the affiliation for Ph.D. continued with the Mangalore University until 2004. Since 2004 the Centre has been affiliated to the Hampi Kannada University. Dr. Padekallu Vishnu Bhat, Dr. Mahabaleshwara Rao, Dr. D.R. Panduranga, Dr. H.S. Shivaswamy, Dr. Malathi K. Murthy, Dr. B. Jagadeesh Shetty, Dr. Uppangala Rama Bhat, Dr. Pundikai Ganapayya Bhat, Dr. Malini Adiga and Dr. Gayathri Navada have been recognized as guides for research in different areas. Fourteen scholars have obtained their Doctorate degrees through this Kendra and many more scholars have registered themselves and are working on their research projects.

The most important project undertaken by the Govind Pai Samshodhana Kendra has been the Tulu-Lexicon Project with Dr. U.P. Upadhyaya as the Chief-Editor and Dr. Mrs Susheela P. Upadhyaya and other scholars on the editorial staff. After a dialect survey of the Tulu speaking areas in the initial period a trilingual dictionary has been prepared on most scientific lines. With the release of the last three volumes in September 1997 the giant 6 volume dictionary of 3332 pages and more than one lakh Tulu words has been accomplished.

The Lexicon has been recognized as the best dialect dictionary ever published in an Indian language. The whole set of volumes is available at a moderate price of Rs. 620/-.The Kendra has engaged itself in promoting literary activities and publication.

REGIONAL RESOURCES CENTRE FOR FOLK PERFORMING ARTS

Invaluable archives have been built under the auspices of the Regional Resources Centre for Folk Performing Arts with the help of the grants offered by the Ford Foundation. The centre has produced rich documentation material in an audiovisual form based on a series of field-studies, workshops, seminars and festivals. The centre has entered into international collaboration in documentation projects.

The Ford Foundation offered a liberal grant to the College, initially for a two year period to launch the project of surveying and documenting the folk theatre forms of Karnataka. The grant was renewed subsequently and thereafter, to enable the institution to sustain itself the Ford Foundation sanctioned endowment grants to the tune of 38.75 lakhs which were matched by an equal contribution from the Academy of General Education to institute a corpus fund. Computerised documentation and retrieval of information is a speciality of the RRC. The RRC has established itself as a major documentation centre of folklore.

YAKSHAGANA KENDRA

The school for Yakshagana was started in 1971. Training in Yakshagana dance and Music is imparted to young enthusiasts who wish to join professional troupes as artistes.

The Yakshagana Kendra has also been running a professional Yakshagana dance ensemble called Yaksharanga for the promotion of Yakshagana as a theatre art. It has the credit of presenting Yakshagana performances in almost all continents of the world in several performance tours.

A new Art Complex “**Shivaprabha**” has come up in the venue of Yakshagana Kendra with extra amenities and facilities for residents, teachers and guests.

DEPARTMENT OF GERMAN

German classes are being held throughout the year at five successive levels : Basic 01, Basic 02, Basic 03, Intermediate 01, Intermediate 02. Examinations are conducted internally by the Department and the Certificates are issued by the College. Examinations of Max Mueller Bhavan, Chennai can also be held for those who are specially interested.

KARNATAKA STATE OPEN UNIVERSITY

M.G.M. has been rendering service to the public through the active functioning of the Study Centre of Karnataka State Open University in the Campus. More than 2500 students have enrolled themselves for various graduate and post graduate courses.
